

How to Add the Panopto Block to Moodle Courses

Overview

In order for your Moodle Course to show the Panopto content that has been recorded, you'll need to enable the Panopto Block on your course page which will be explained in this documentation.

Prerequisites

- Faculty or staff member in Moodle

1. Provision Individual Moodle Courses

Note: Before proceeding, make sure you are logged in with a Moodle account that has permission to add blocks.

1.1. In the course you are adding the Panopto block to, select **Turn Editing On** in the upper right-hand corner (Fig. 1).

1.2. At the bottom of the left hand navigation, select **Add a Block** (Fig. 2).

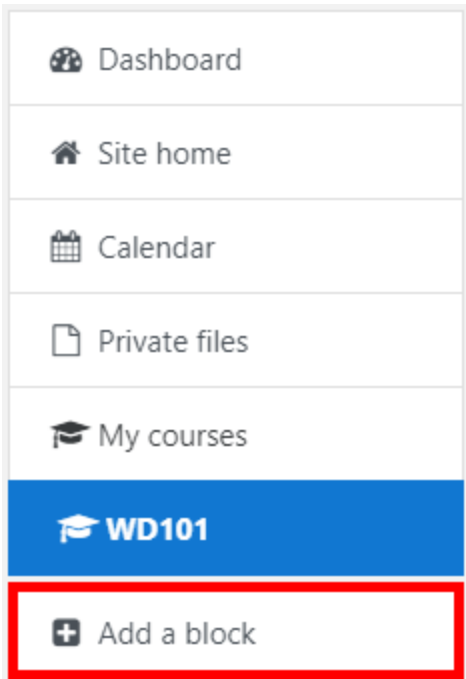

1.3. On the **Add a Block** pop up menu, scroll down and select **Panopto** (Fig. 3).

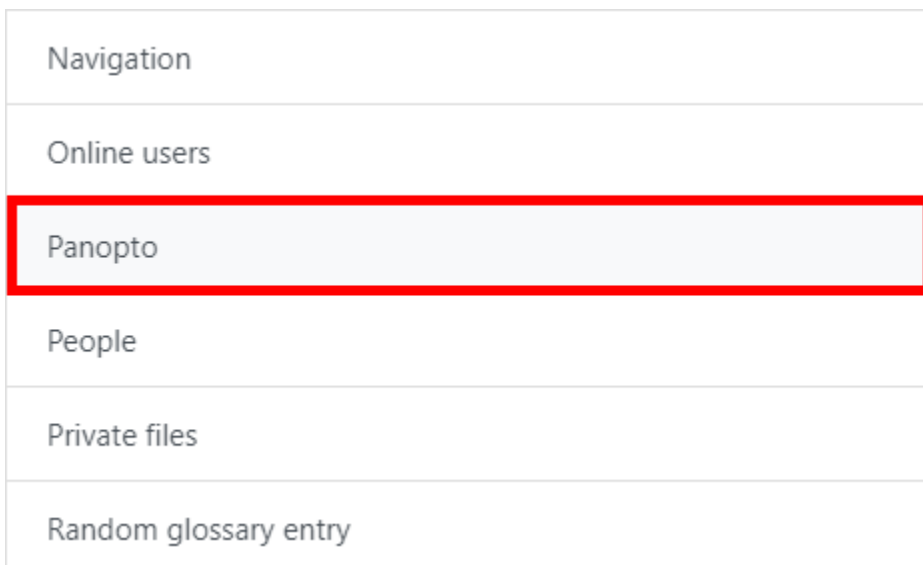

(Fig. 4).

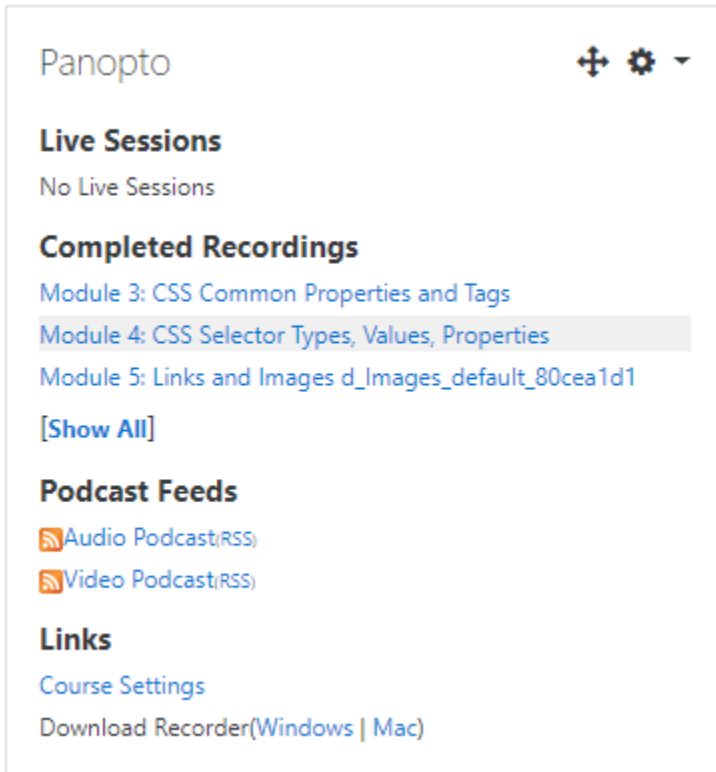

1.5. If the course needs to be provisioned and added to Panopto, select **Provision Course** (Fig. 5a).

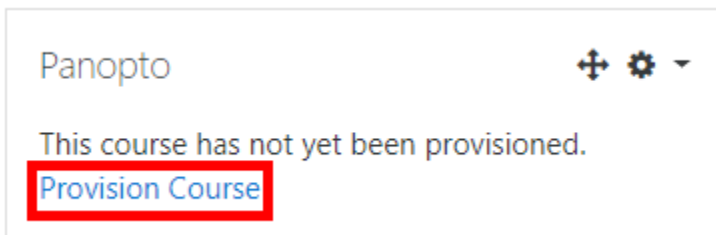
